Key Reasons We Paint Iron

Prevents Rust



Paint forms a protective layer that stops air and water from touching the iron.

Increases Life



Keeps iron stronger for a longer time.

Improves Appearance



Gives a smooth, clean and attractive finish with colour.

Protects from Weather



Shields iron from rain, moisture, sunlight and harsh conditions.

How Paint Protects Iron



Air and water cause rust on iron.



Paint is applied on the iron surface.



Paint creates a tough, waterproof cover.



The cover blocks air and water, stopping rust.



So, we paint iron articles to protect them from rust, keep them strong, make them look good and last longer!
